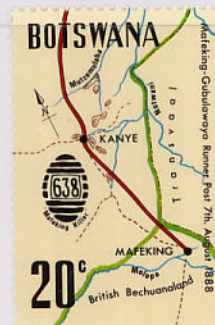


Mafeking (1900)

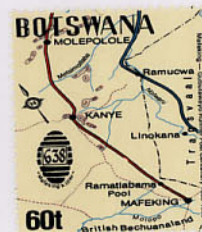

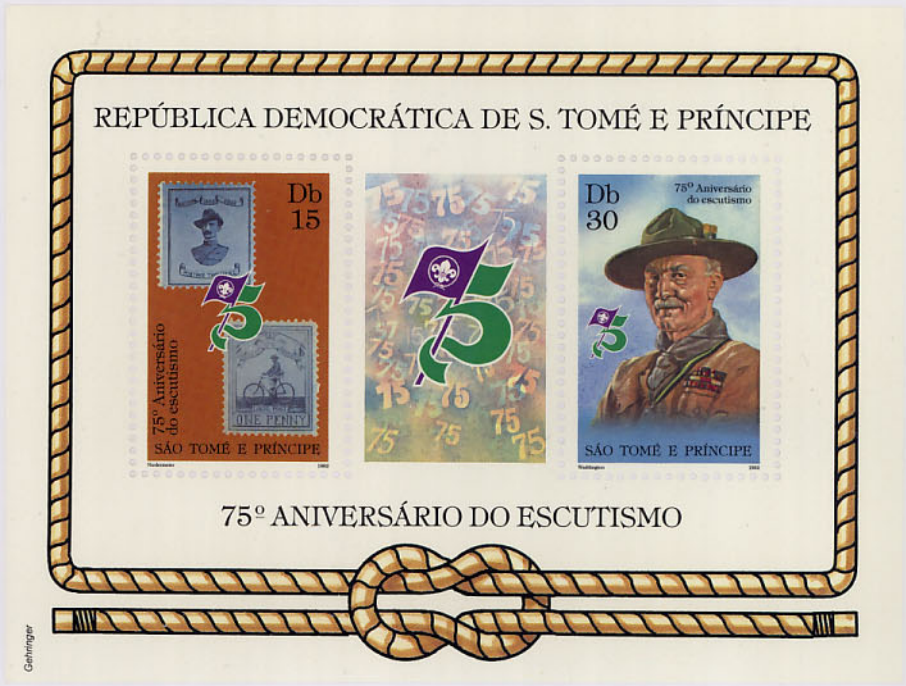
