

British Zanzibar (1895-1964)

A group of islands off the coast of Tanganyika in East Africa. Zanzibar was occupied by the Portuguese and Arabs. In 1885, the sultanate's mainland possessions were divided between Germany, Great Britain and Italy. In 1890, the islands were placed under British protection. On Dec. 10, 1963, Zanzibar became independent, and in January 1964, the sultan was deposed. In April 1964, Zanzibar joined with Tanganyika to form the United Republic of Tanganyika and Zanzibar, renamed Tanzania.
