

Sudan (1956 -)

In 1954, the Sudan became self-governing and, on Jan. 1, 1956, became an independent republic. In 1969, a military coup brought a socialist regime to power, and in 1970, the government nationalized a number of businesses. In 1992 the government imposed militant Islam throughout the nation, and Sudan has since become a haven for Arab terrorists.
