

Algeria (1962-)

France seized the coastal region in 1830 and during the 19th century expanded its rule inland. After World War II, in 1958, Algeria became an integral part of France, and French stamps replaced those of the colony. In 1962 Algeria became independent and resumed issuing its own stamps. Since independence, Algeria has been ruled by socialist and military governments.
