

Zaire

(1971-1997)

The Congo Democratic Republic, formerly the Belgian Congo, adopted the name Zaire in November 1971. In 1977 and 1978, Shabani (Katangan) exiles invaded Zaire from Angola. Mobutu's corrupt and repressive regime brought economic stagnation to Zaire, and attempts in the early 1990s to establish a multiparty government were unsuccessful. In 1997 a rebellion, overthrew Mobutu. The new government, under Laurent Kabila, assumed the old name of Democratic Republic of the Congo.
