

Western Sahara (1975 -)

A disputed territory on the northwest coast and in the Maghreb region of North and West Africa. After 1939 and the outbreak of World War II, this area was administered by Spanish Morocco. Occupied by Spain until 1975, Western Sahara has been on the United Nations list of non-self-governing territories since 1963 after a Moroccan demand. About 20% of the territory is controlled by the self-proclaimed Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic (SADR), while the remaining 80% of the territory is occupied and administered by neighboring Morocco.
