

British Palestine

(1918-1947)

In 1918, British and Arab forces occupied the Turkish Asian provinces bordering on the eastern Mediterranean. Britain's military administration issued stamps inscribed "E.E.F." (Egyptian Expeditionary Forces) that were used in Palestine, Trans-Jordan, Lebanon, Syria and in parts of Cilicia and northeast Egypt. In 1920, British civil administration was established in Palestine. In 1948, Britain partitioned the country between the two groups and withdrew her forces, precipitating the first Arab-Israeli War.
