

Indonesia (Japan Occupation) (1940-1944)

A republic occupying most of the Malay Archipelago in southeastern Asia; formerly the Netherlands East Indies. The area remained under Dutch control until its occupation by Japan in 1942. In August 1945, Indonesian nationalists under Achmed Sukarno proclaimed the independent Republic of Indonesia in central Java and throughout most of Sumatra.
