
(1938 - 1950)

Four postage stamps from North Korea commemorating Mao Zedong's 110th birthday. Each stamp features a different scene or portrait related to his life and the Chinese Revolution. The stamps are arranged in a 2x2 grid. The top-left stamp shows Mao with other men in a meeting. The top-right stamp shows Mao and another man standing by a body of water. The bottom-left stamp shows Mao leading a group of people in a revolutionary scene. The bottom-right stamp is a portrait of Mao in military uniform. Each stamp includes the text '조선우표' (North Korean Postage), '주제 92 (2003) DPR KOREA', and a value of 20 or 30 won. The year '1936' is also visible on the bottom-right stamp.
