

Vietnam Socialist Republic (1976 -)

. In 1964, North Vietnamese troops began to fight in the South, bringing the U.S. actively into the war. In early 1975, a renewed communist offensive brought about the rapid collapse of the South Vietnamese regime, and a communist government was installed in the South. In 1976, the two countries were merged into the Socialist Republic of Vietnam.
