

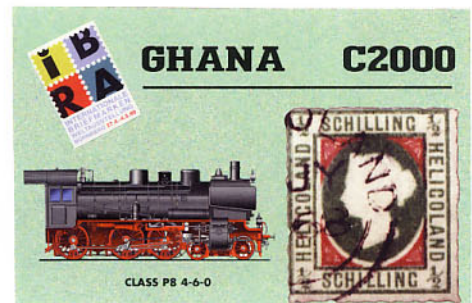
Heligoland

(1867-1890)

A strategically located island in the North Sea, Heligoland was ceded to Great Britain by Denmark in 1807. Britain transferred the island to Germany in 1890, in exchange for some German claims in East Africa. Heligoland was returned to Germany in 1952. Since 1890, German stamps have been used.
