

Sweden

(1855-)

Constitutional monarchy in northern Europe, occupying the eastern portion of the Scandinavian Peninsula. In 1813, Sweden joined in the war against Napoleon, receiving Norway (independent 1905) as compensation. In 1976, 44 years of socialist government ended with the election of a conservative coalition. Conservatives and Social Democrats have since alternated in power, attempting to maintain the high quality of life in Sweden.

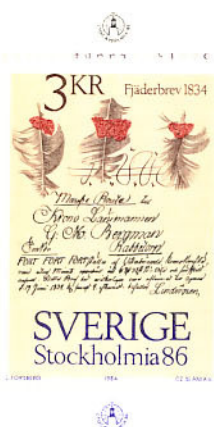
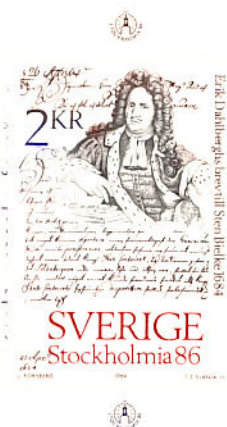
