

# Bosnia & Herzegovina

(1879-1918, 1992-)

Located in southwestern Yugoslavia. After nearly five centuries of Ottoman Turkish rule, they were placed under Austrian protection in 1878, and a year later their first separate stamps appeared. In 1908, Austria-Hungary formally annexed Bosnia-Herzegovina. After World War I, Bosnia and Herzegovina became part of the newly established Kingdom of Yugoslavia. In 1991 the Bosnia and Herzegovina parliament declared the state's sovereignty and in early 1992 declared independence from Yugoslavia.
