(1960-)

A large island in the eastern Mediterranean. In 1878, the British occupied the island, formally annexing it in 1914. In 1960 independence was achieved. On 1974, a pro-Greek coup deposed the elected government and Turkey invaded Cyprus and occupied the northeastern of the island. In 1975, Turkish Cypriots voted to establish a separate state. In 1983 this government declared its independence as the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus.

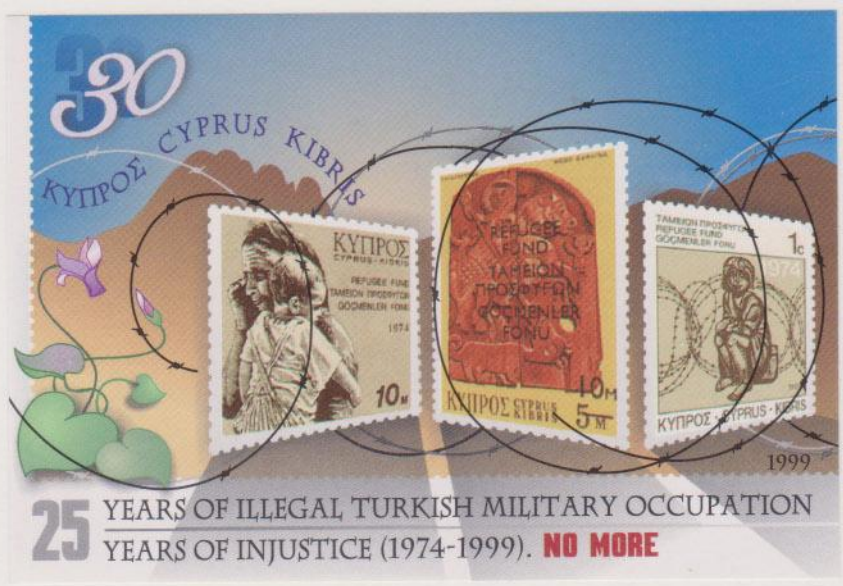
