Hungary

(1871-)

A republic in East Central Europe. Austria completely dominated Hungary until the mid-19th century. Magyar nationalism forced the creation of the Austro-Hungarian Monarchy in 1867, after which Hungary was an equal partner with Austria. During 1918-20, the country was overrun by Serbian, French and Romanian armies and was torn by civil war between royalist and Bolshevik factions. Hungary emerged in 1920 as a nationalist state. On Feb. 1, 1946, a republic was established, but in 1947, the communists ousted the president. In 1989, the Communist Party was dissolved, and in 1991, the last Soviet troops left the country.
